We take advantage of this new edition of Le Messager to acknowledge our dear colleague Anne Pouleur's 30-year dedication to municipal management.



Urban Planning and Regulations

The revised version of the draft urban planning plans and bylaws that were introduced last spring will be adopted during the December 6, 2021 meeting. Once adopted, these bylaws will become public and you can access them via frelighsburg.ca.

To give you enough time to consult the changes made and to form an informed opinion on the content of the modifications, the Municipality will wait until January 17, 2022, before opening the register.

As of January 17, those who oppose the proposed overhaul will then be able to stat_e their opposition. If the required number of signatures is obtained, a referendum allowing all the qualified voters to express themselves will then be held on our territory. More details on the dates and terms will be published in the next Messenger.

Two positions to be filled in the Urban Planning Advisory Committee

The election of Marie Claude Aubin as councillor and the moving of a member outside the territory of the Municipality have freed up two positions of citizen representatives within the Urban Planning Advisory Committee.

What is the Urban Planning Advisory Committee? This is a committee mandated by the Municipal Council to make recommendations on submitted requests regarding by-law on-site planning and architectural integration as well as on minor variations. This workgroup is made up of one member of the Municipal Council and four residents chosen by the Council to guide, direct and support its town-planning actions.

Do you want to sit on the Urban Planning Advisory Committee? This Committee normally meets once a month, in the afternoon. If you are available and wish to submit your application, send a letter of interest and your resume to municipalite@frelighsburg.ca or drop them off at the Town Hall before December 17, 2021. The Municipal Council will meet in December to select members, whose two-year term will begin in January 2022.
