
Brome-Missisquoi Pact: over \$300 000 available for projects

Cowansville, the 20th of September 2017 – The MRC Brome-Missisquoi is launching a project call for the Brome-Missisquoi Pact. \$300 000 is available to fund projects presented by non-profit organisations, cooperatives and municipalities. Formerly known as the Rural Pact, the MRC is celebrating the 15th year of this fund. Over the years, over 5.4 M was invested in various projects that contributed in the development of culture, community, economy, tourism, leisure infrastructure and much more

Municipalities and organisations that wish to present a request can download the guide and the application form from the MRC website at www.mrcbm.qc.ca. Both documents are available in English. The MRC will also hold information sessions in the month of October. The chosen dates will soon be posted on the website. Please note these information sessions will be held in French but that the presenter will translate and answer questions in English if needed.

The deadline to submit an application is the 26th of January 2018. All decisions will be announced following the mayors` council taking place in March 2018.
